You must have only this variety for Algebra 2, Pre-Calculus, Calculus, College Prep Math,

Chemistry, and Physics. A graphing calculator is acceptable but not required. A Texas instruments TI-89 or above is not acceptable.

* 3. Access to a computer is required for several classes. Reports and essays are often requested to be finished in typed form. Computers in the computer lab are not available for assignments other than their respective class, however, all students have access to word processing and the Internet at their local library.
